

Class 14: NNU hired on or after 01/01/1994

• Short-term Disability is salary continuation (to replace income lost during a leave) provided to UCM employees at no cost to the employee

When am I eligible?	NNU employees hired after 01/01/1994 and working 20 hours or more hours per week are eligible for Short-term disability.
Who do I contact?	In order to request Short-term disability, you must contact Sedgwick at 855-311-9661.
How will I receive pay?	Once approved, you will receive pay on the normal bi-weekly pay date in the same manner you receive your regular pay check.
When should I request a leave?	You should contact Sedgwick as soon as you become aware of the need for a leave.
